



# MASTER OF MEDICINE (ANAESTHESIOLOGY)

## Entry Requirements

### Applicants must fulfill the following conditions:

- Candidates must have Doctor of Medicine (MD) or equivalent qualification recognized by the Senate.
- Candidates must be fully registered with the Malaysian Medical Council (MMC).
- The candidate must have experience in clinical anesthesia of not less than one (1) year after full registration with the Malaysian Medical Council.
- Fulfill the University and Ministry of Health Malaysia requirement (applicable to MOH's officer only)

### Entry requirements for international students:

For direct admission, all international candidates from countries where English is not a medium of instruction must have obtained one of the following:

The Master of Medicine (Anesthesiology) is a 4-year academic program designed to equip graduates with comprehensive knowledge and clinical skills in the field of anesthesiology, along with sufficient exposure to its subspecialties.

The program aims to produce competent anesthesiology specialists who are capable of critical thinking, committed to lifelong learning, and able to continue their medical education independently. In addition, the program emphasizes the development of leadership skills, enabling graduates to lead resuscitation teams effectively and serve as experts in providing anesthesiology and intensive care services.

Graduates of this program will demonstrate strong social accountability and are expected to serve as consultants who contribute to the advancement of anesthesiology practices, standards, and professional expertise.

### PHASE I: YEAR 1

- Phase I for one (1) year. This phase includes Basic Physiology, Pharmacology and Anesthesiology I. (Physiology, Pharmacology, Basic Anaesthesiology, Professional Exam I)

### PHASE II: YEAR 2 TO YEAR 3 MIDDLE

- Phase II is for one and a half (1 ½) years. Phase II consists of Basic Anesthesiology, Anesthesiology Special, Intensive Care and Research Project. (2 years - Basic Anaesthesiology II, Specialized Anaesthesiology I, Intensive Care, General Medicine, Advanced Anaesthesiology, Research Project)

### PHASE III: MID-YEAR 3 TO YEAR 4

- Phase III is for one and a half (1 ½) years. Phase III includes Special Surgery, General Medicine, Anesthesiology and Advanced Senior Apprenticeship. (1 year - Specialized Anaesthesiology II, Research project, Senior Apprenticeship, Professional Exam II)
